Teaching Assistant (Level 3)

New course starting soon!

Teacher (Level 6)

- Postgraduate qualification following a bachelor's degree, with pathways for teaching pupils from 3 – 19 years
- Apprentices are trained and assessed to achieve Qualified Teacher Status
- Duration: 24 months



Early Years Educator (Level 3)

- Mapping to the roles of nursery nurse and nursery assistant, the apprenticeship will enable the individual to support the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old
- Duration: 18 months



Supporting Teaching and Learning in PE and School Sport (Level 3)

- A vocational pathway into the provision of Children's Physical Activity and School Sport delivery and development, in a range of environments including schools and the community
- Duration: 13 months



Master's Degree in Educational Leadership (Level 7)

- Designed specifically for leaders in schools and multi-academy trusts, this apprenticeship brings together leadership expertise from the private, public and third sectors.
- The programme is immersed in educational context while also developing leadership theory and practice that is transferable across sectors.
- Duration 26 months
