



Teaching Apprenticeships available for Schools in Norfolk

Teaching Assistant – Level 3

- Delivered by *Adult Learning*, who provide an established and high-quality teaching, learning and assessment experience for apprentices.
- The apprenticeship will enable the member of staff to support the class teacher effectively to enhance pupils' learning either in groups or individually.
- Duration: 12 months
- Start dates are available throughout the year – contact the Apprenticeships Team to register your interest

Teacher – Level 6

- Postgraduate qualification following a bachelor's degree, with pathways for teaching pupils from 3 – 19 years
- Apprentices are trained and assessed to achieve Qualified Teacher Status
- Duration: 24 months

Early Years Educator – Level 3

- Mapping to the roles of nurse/nurse and nursery assistant, the apprenticeship will enable the individual to support the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old
- Duration: 18 months

Community Activator Coach – Level 2

- The Community Activator Coach promotes, delivers and coaches fun, inclusive and engaging activities that help whole communities to change their behaviour, adopt and keep to a physically active lifestyle.
- Duration: 18 months



Sports Coach – Level 4

- The broad purpose of the Sport Coach occupation is to use extensive technical and tactical sports knowledge and skills to design and deliver coaching programmes that engage, motivate and evolve participants' skills and performance.
- Duration: 18 months

Apprenticeships are a fantastic opportunity to upskill existing employees and attract great candidates to hard to fill roles. Apprenticeship training can be funded through the Apprenticeship levy, and is provided by an external organisation, leaving you free to enjoy the benefits of a skilled, qualified and motivated employee.
